Each session will last around 45 minutes and you'll be brought back to us here at University House between each one for a quick warm up and a brew between sessions. Tea and coffee are on tap all day so please feel free to help yourselves.

Lunch break

Lunch will be arriving at around 12.15pm and topped up again at 12.45pm when the majority of the morning sessions will finish. Lunch includes halal and vegetarian options or if you'd prefer to find an alternative, then Atmosphere Bar or Café are well stocked with different food choices and Starbucks coffee. Atmosphere is run by our Students' Union so even if you don't want to eat there, do try and pop your head in to see what the social side of university is like.

Afternoon sessions

Welcome Talk

After lunch we'll take you over to Chapman Building, Lecture Theatre 3 for your Welcome Talk. We realise it's a little quirky to have the Welcome Talk in the middle of the day but as the morning is optional, it's the first time the whole group will be together. Today's talk will be delivered by Hannah Burchell who's one of our Associate Directors.

Course sessions

At the end of the Welcome Talk we'll divide you into groups and take you over to your course session. You'll find a detailed overview for your course session in your Applicant Visit Day Guide booklet showing exactly what you'll be doing during the afternoon.

Most subject sessions will last around 2 hours, with some continuing until 5pm depending on the type of activity you're doing. All sessions will include a refreshment break and parents are welcome to stay with applicants for the session.

Getting home again

Once the academic sessions have finished, the park and ride coach will take you back up to the car park by our old Centenary Building. The first coach leaves at 3.30pm coaches will then run every 8-10 minutes until the final one leaves at 5.30pm. The coach pick up point is the same as where you were dropped off, by building number 13 on the map. Look out for our ambassadors in red to point you in the right direction.

During the afternoon, we'll be based in Chapman Building so if you think of anything you've forgotten to ask, or if we can help with anything, feel free to pop by.
