# GETTING HELP DURING THE OPEN DAY

## CHECK-IN DESKS

All of our check-in desks are staffed by members of the Recruitment Team who can help you with questions about the day, about how to find your way around campus or provide any other assistance if you need it.

## STUDENT AMBASSADORS

You'll spot our friendly Student Ambassadors and Marshals around campus all day – they're wearing red tops and they'll be happy to help you out. They're all current students and are happy to answer any questions about studying at Salford, as well as questions about the Open Day.

## FIRE ALARM

In the event of a fire alarm during the Open Day, please exit the building as quickly and safely as possible. Our staff and students will help you find your way to the nearest fire assembly point.

## ILLNESS OR INJURY

If you feel ill or need first aid assistance during the day, please speak to a member of staff at any check-in point who will be able to arrange assistance for you.

# FINDING YOUR WAY AROUND

Our **Open Days** take place across our **three campuses**, including **MediaCityUK**. The location of your subject presentation and facilities tour will depend on the course you are interested in. You can find out which courses are based where on pages 8-25.

## MAPS

Pick up a map at any of our check-in desks, and if you need pointing in the right direction, just ask one of our student ambassadors.

## BUSES

Two different bus loops will be running during the day: a MediaCityUK shuttle and our Accommodation shuttle.

## VISITING MEDIACITYUK

For visitors to our MediaCityUK campus, we are running a shuttle departing from New Adelphi Building every 15 minutes, which, on its return journey, will also stop at both of our accommodation sites.

Parking is limited at MediaCityUK and there is a charge. So if you're driving to our Open Day, we recommend parking for free at the main University campus, then catching the shuttle to MediaCityUK from New Adelphi Building. Free parking is available at Irwell Place car park (use the postcode M5 4WT to park at Irwell Place).


If you do decide to drive to MediaCityUK and have a sat nav, you can use the postcode M50 2EQ.

## ACCOMMODATION SHUTTLE




Our teaching and learning facilities are split between our three sites...

## PEEL PARK

Our main campus, Peel Park, offers you the best of both worlds: state-of-the-art learning facilities within minutes of a world-class city, set against beautiful green spaces to relax and socialise in. We've built our campus with everyone who uses it in mind – our students, staff, businesses and local residents and created a space where everyone feels welcome. Our friendly security team is consistently recognised and accredited for their efforts in keeping everyone safe on campus.

## FREDERICK ROAD

Frederick Road campus, just ten minutes' walk from Peel Park, is home to our nursing, midwifery, psychology, social sciences, sports and health sciences courses. Here you'll find state-of-the-art facilities to equip you with the skills and knowledge you'll need for a successful and fulfilling career.



Peel Park was the first public park in the United Kingdom funded entirely by the people's subscription, to officially open. Created in 1846, it was free to use and brought all Salford residents together. Benefiting from a recent £1.6 million transformation, the park provides a beautiful green space to relax outside of lessons.

## MEDIACITYUK

We are the only university to have a campus at MediaCityUK, the home of TV, digital and creative businesses in the north – including the BBC and ITV. It's a lively, professional environment, with a wide range of restaurants, bars, shops and leisure facilities. MediaCityUK houses our journalism centre, which includes a TV studio, newsroom, radio studio and editing gallery. There's also the digital performance lab – an experimental performance and lecture space, perfect for showcasing computer gaming, animation and dance. ## ANECHOIC CHAMBER

Our anechoic chamber, also known as the quietest place on Earth, is used by our acoustics students and for commercial testing.

## AERODYNAMICS LABORATORY

For students of aeronautical engineering, we have our very own aerodynamics laboratory and two different flight simulators, which will give you a practical experience of aircraft.



## BODMER LABORATORY

Our Bodmer lab is packed with cutting-edge technical equipment to help you make new discoveries of your own; with AV and HDTV systems that connect you to your lecturers, wherever you are in the lab.



## HUMAN PERFORMANCE LAB

The Human Performance Lab is a teaching and research facility used by students on our sport and exercise courses, as well as physiotherapy, podiatry and prosthetics and orthotics.

## JOURNALISM CENTRE

Based at MediaCityUK, this centre includes a TV studio, newsroom, radio studio and editing gallery. Here, our journalism students produce digital content across multiple channels, developing and honing their reporting and content production skills.

## SIMULATION SUITE

When you train to become a nurse, midwife or allied health professional here at Salford, you'll face real-life scenarios in the safe and supportive environment of our Simulation Suite. Set up just like a hospital ward, the suite is equipped with human patient simulators, including two adults, a newborn baby, a child and a birthing mum.

## NEW ADELPHI THEATRE

The theatre is equipped with the latest lighting, PA equipment and high-powered projection, seating for up to 350 people, and can be adapted to different configurations.

The Lowry Theatre, named after the Salford artist LS Lowry and located at Salford Quays, hosts plays, comedy shows, dance performances, family activities and gallery exhibitions – right on our doorstep next to MediaCityUK.

Islington Mill, just a ten minute walk from Peel Park campus, is home to radical, subversive music and visual arts, with an eclectic mix of events and exhibitions to inspire and surprise you.

HOME, located in central Manchester is more than a cinema: it's Manchester's centre for international contemporary art, theatre and film, complete with a bar and restaurant. We're proud to be founding partners of HOME, which opens up opportunities for students such as gaining direct industry involvement in the curriculum on relevant courses.

Want to enjoy your culture even closer to home? Our campus is home to New Adelphi Theatre, a 350-seat theatre which hosts a range of events, from side-splitting comedy to ground breaking dance projects and big band entertainment, involving both our own students and external companies.

## FOOD AND DRINK

We admit it, we're a bunch of foodies here – but you can find a lot more than avocado toast at one of the nearby many food and drink establishments.

Salford's Chapel Street, just a few minutes' walk from main campus, is home to a growing number of independent outlets including veggie favourite Deli Lama, authentic Italian pizza at Vero Moderno, freshly made tapas at Porta and beautiful cakes and artwork at GK Gallery.

In Manchester's Northern Quarter it's all about quirky diners, canteens and cafes, whilst the city's Chinatown is the second biggest in the UK, with a host of Chinese, Korean and Japanese restaurants, as well as a number of speciality supermarkets. Just outside of the city centre you'll find Rusholme's famous 'curry mile' offering Indian, South East Asian and Middle Eastern cuisine.

## MUSIC

The Manchester music scene is more than Morrissey and Madchester (although Bez does still make an appearance now and again). Whatever your music taste, you'll never be stuck for gigs in the city.

Catch the biggest national and international acts at Manchester Arena, the Apollo and Manchester Academy, and see your favourite indie and underground artists at Northern Quarter venues Night and Day and Soup Kitchen. Manchester's alternative music scene still roars, with gigs at Rebellion, the Star and Garter and DIY venue Partisan.

The University itself has been host to a range of great artists over the years as well, from The Who in 1968 and Status Quo in 1972, to The Smiths in the 1986 and Pulp in 1992. We're currently making plans to re-develop Maxwell Hall so it can play host once more to the stars of the future!

## SHOPPING

Ever wonder where Mancunians get their unique street style? The Northern Quarter is home to the best independent, vintage and boutique shops, as well as Afflecks Palace, with four floors

of alternative fashion. You can find all your high street favourites in Manchester Arndale centre, and designer labels in the city centre.

## SPORT

We're home to two of the biggest teams in football, Manchester United and Manchester City (the Students' Union offers discounted tickets to some matches!) as well as Lancashire County Cricket Club at Emirates Old Trafford. Sportcity at the Etihad Campus houses the National Cycling Centre and Velodrome, the National Squash Centre and regional Tennis Centre.

If you like your sports a little less theatre of dreams and a little more grassroots, Manchester and Salford are also home to a community of active and enthusiastic non-league football teams, as well as rugby, hockey and roller derby teams. You can even try your hand at outdoor swimming at Salford Quays, next to our MediaCityUK campus.

On campus itself we have the Sports Centre, where facilities include a 25 metre swimming pool with spa and sauna, a fitness studio with strength and conditioning rooms, and multi-use sports hall for badminton, basketball, netball and five-a-side-football.




