Disabled access

All buildings have level or ramped access and lifts except Horlock/Constantine Courts. The campus is not level, so there are some slopes, including a couple of quite steep paths. Campus Link

The University runs a free bus service during term time, linking the academic campus, periphery car parks and accommodation sites. The bus is scheduled to operate at regular half hour intervals from 8.15 until 23.15 (ending at Castle Irwell).

Travelling to MediaCityUK

QuaysLink bus to MediaCityUK runs between Salford Crescent station, Salford Shopping City and Salford Quays. The service runs every 10 minutes during the day Monday-Friday and every 15 minutes in the evening and weekends. Staff and students travel free on production of their University ID cards.

The Metrolink tram service runs every six minutes in both directions between Manchester city centre and MediaCityUK. The two mile journey takes around 15 minutes, connecting with the national rail network at Victoria and Piccadilly. If travelling by car, parking is limited at the MediaCityUK public multi-storey car park. The car park is accessed via Broadway.

Travelling to the University

Travel by train

Salford Crescent station is located on the campus. Direct services run to and from Manchester Airport, Manchester Piccadilly (for connecting to Inter city services) and Victoria, Blackpool, Bolton, Buxton, Blackburn, Southport, Preston, Lancaster and Barrow-in-Furness.

Travel by air

Manchester International Airport is 15 miles from the University. There are regular direct train services to and from Salford Crescent station and Manchester Piccadilly. Buses 43A, 45A, 84A and 105 link the airport and the city centre.

Travel by car

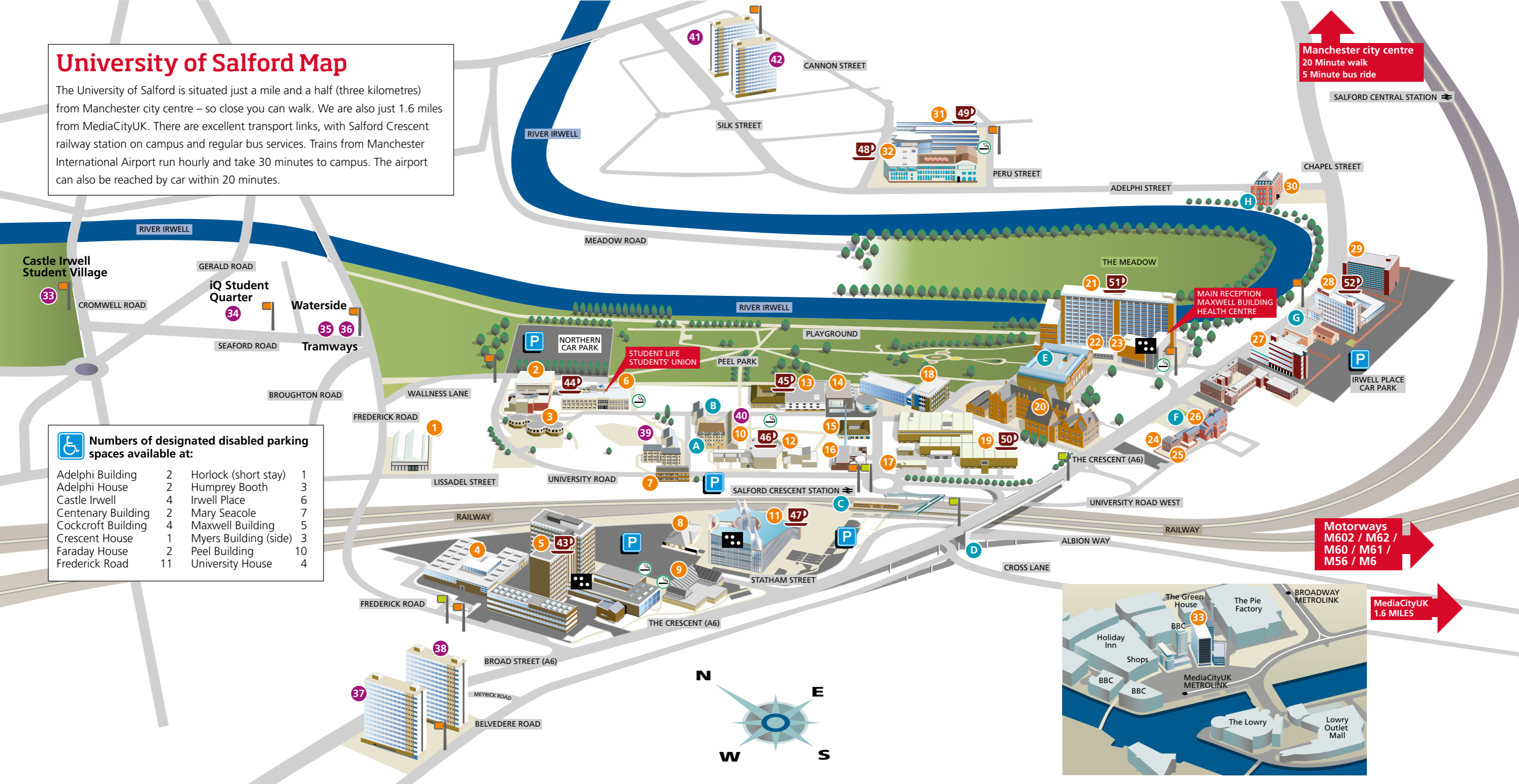

The University of Salford is situated just a mile and a half (three kilometres) from Manchester city centre – so close you can walk. We are also just 1.6 miles from MediaCityUK. There are excellent transport links, with Salford Crescent railway station on campus and regular bus services. Trains from Manchester International Airport run hourly and take 30 minutes to campus. The airport can also be reached by car within 20 minutes.
