9am	<b>Check-in opens</b>	There will be check-in points on Peel Park, Frederick Road and MediaCityUK campuses.
As your subject sessions are taking place in the afternoon, there are a variety of options for you during the morning. You can see more about optional sessions running overleaf, plus a list of catering outlets open if you fancy a brew and a bite to eat.		
1:15pm – 4pm		<p>The first session of the morning is a welcome talk. Your welcome talk will be held on our Peel Park campus in <b>Maxwell Hall</b>. Your subject-specific session will then be held on the same campus but in our New Adelphi Building.</p> <p>Your subject session will include a range of different activities as detailed below.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>1. Welcome and introduction to Music at the University of Salford</b> (New Adelphi reception) Director for Music &amp; Dance Tim France and academic staff from your programme will provide an overview of your course.</li><li><b>2. Student stories and Q&amp;A</b> We will introduce to you three students who represent our three programmes, who will tell you about their life in Salford and their progression and development through the courses.</li></ol> <p>They will play extracts of their music, explaining more about the recording facilities and the benefits of interacting with others within this exciting and diverse department. These recordings reflect our rich variety of composition modules and performance modules allowing you to hear how our curriculum reflects the professional environment.</p>

	<p>A key aspect to our teaching is that we encourage students to write original material that feeds directly into the bands they want to create. All our rehearsal and recording facilities are in the same building and new equipment is provided every year, with our students taking up the many opportunities available to them as live performers, regardless of genre or style.</p> <p>Musicology is also an important subject area for us and the students will highlight the appropriation of this towards dissertation, research and the understanding of their other modules</p> <p>The session will be held in one of our brilliant new studios, giving you the opportunity to hear and see our industry standard software and hardware. Our students will also explain the benefits of not only our high tech facilities, but Salford's location to Manchester and MediaCityUK, and the various work and collaboration opportunities.</p> <p>Parents and guests are welcome to attend the session and are encouraged to take part.</p>
