Connecting a Personal Windows 7 Laptop to the UoS-WiFi service

The University of Salford has added a seamless way to connect your devices to the wireless network available on campus; this user guide will provide instructions on how to connect a personally owned Windows 7 laptop using the new method. Using this method of connecting will allow your device to seamlessly authenticate whenever it is in range of the wireless service on campus, avoiding the need to constantly enter your username and password into a webpage.

Connecting to the UoS-WiFi service:

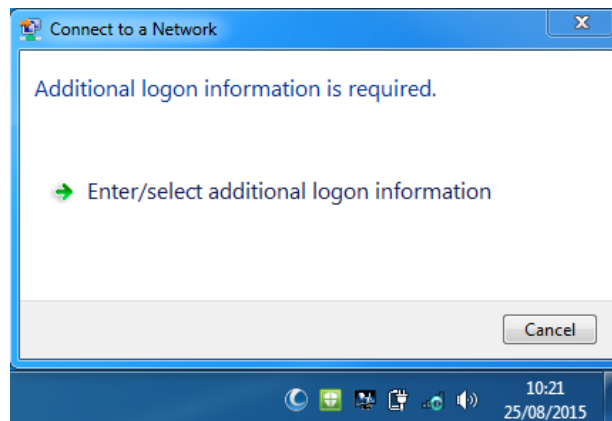
- From your Desktop find and click the **wireless** icon () in the System Tray at the bottom right of the screen.
- Select and click the **UoS-WiFi** option in the Wireless popup list:



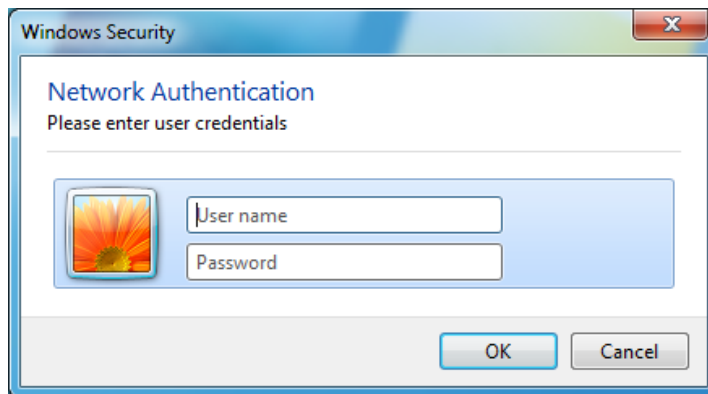
- You may be presented with a certificate popup. Click **Connect**. You may see another popup; click **Connect** again.



- You will be presented with a pop up window asking for **Additional Logon Information**.



- Another box will pop up asking for your **user credentials**. These credentials should be your UoS username and password:



- You will now be connected to the new wireless service (UoS-WiFi).
