

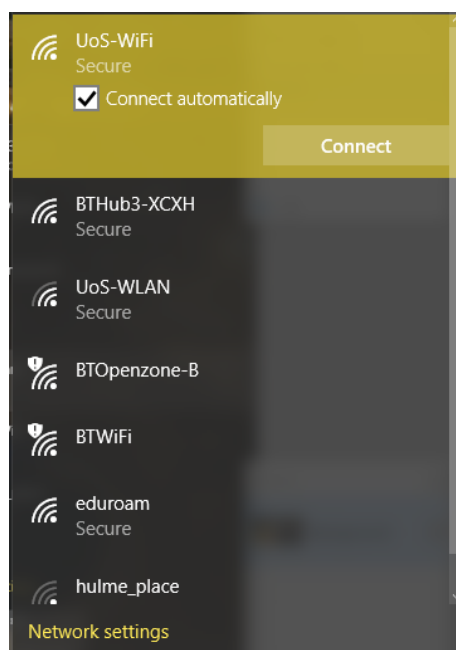
Connecting a personal W10 device to the UoS-WiFi Service

Connecting a personal Windows 10 device to the new UoS-WiFi service

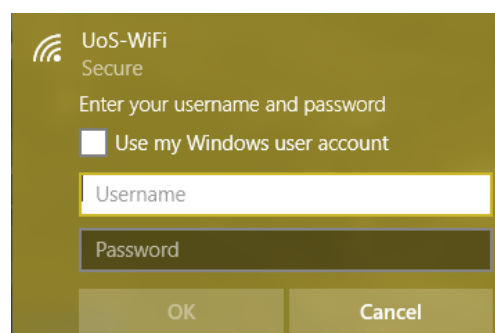
The University of Salford has added a seamless way to connect your devices to the wireless network available on campus; this user guide will provide instructions on how to connect a personally owned Windows 10 laptop or tablet using this method. Using this method of connecting will allow your device to seamlessly authenticate whenever it is in range of the wireless service on campus, avoiding the need to constantly enter your username and password into a webpage.

Connecting to the UoS-WiFi service:

- From your Desktop find and click the **wireless** icon (📶) in the System Tray at the bottom right of the screen.
- Select and click the **UoS-WiFi** option in the Wireless popup list and ensure that **Connect automatically** is checked and then click on the **Connect** button:



- You will be presented with a pop up window asking for your username and password:



- Enter your network username and password and click on **OK**. The system will then show the following:



- You are now connected to the new wireless service (UoS-WiFi).
