

Connecting a Windows Phone to the UoS-WiFi Service

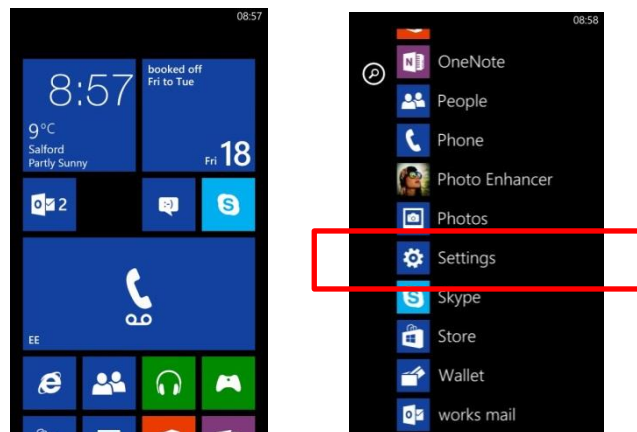
Connecting a Windows phone device to the UoS-WiFi service

The University of Salford has added a seamless way to connect your devices to the wireless network available on campus; this user guide will provide instructions on how to connect a Windows Phone using this method. Using this method of connecting will allow your device to seamlessly authenticate whenever it is in range of the wireless service on campus, avoiding the need to constantly enter your username and password into a webpage.

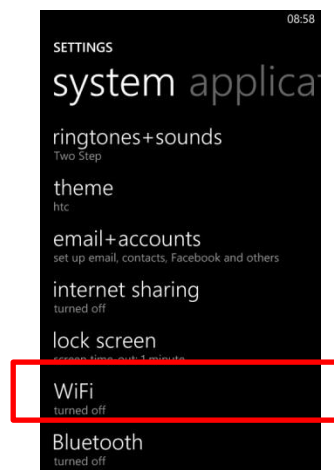
Please note that Windows phone platforms may vary. These instructions use Windows 8 for Phone

Connecting to the UoS-WiFi service:

- From your phones home swipe from right to left to bring up the menu and press **Settings**



- On your **Settings** menu navigate to and press the **Wi-Fi** option



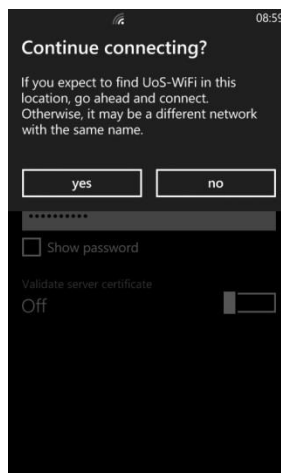
- If the WiFi is turned off. Turn it on by sliding the button across to the right.



- Select **UoS-WiFi**. To take you to the sign in screen. Enter your **UoS Username** e.g abc123 and **UoS Password** and press **done**



- You will be asked if you want to '**continue connecting?**'. Select **yes** to proceed



- You are now connected to the UoS-WiFi wireless service.
