TALKS

Providing timely information and advice can be hugely beneficial to Year 12 and Year 13 students as they make important decisions about their future. We have created our range of talks to inform and encourage students, aiding the transition into Higher Education. Examples of some of the talks we are able to provide are set out below:

/ Introduction to Higher Education

Choosing the right university and course is an important decision but it can be difficult to know where to start with over 37,000 courses in the UK to choose from. Our introduction to HE talk will provide students with information on the benefits of university study, how to choose a course, finance, accommodation and the UCAS process.

/ Personal Statements – Hints and Tips

The Personal Statement is the one chance a student has to show passion for their subject area to universities. Our hints and tips presentation provides students with good and bad examples along with a step-by-step guide to structuring a Personal Statement that makes an impact!

/ Student Finance & Budgeting

Our Student Finance & Budgeting talk encourages students to begin thinking about the outgoing costs of student living and how to successfully manage their finance throughout a degree. We will cover areas such as tuition fees and student loans along with details of the scholarships available at Salford.

/ Why Study at the University of Salford?

Our courses open doors to rewarding and challenging careers in health, science, engineering, the arts, the built environment, media, law and business. This presentation includes details about the campus, accommodation, work placements and extracurricular activity available to students choosing to study with us.



PEEL PARK CAMPUS

Our main campus, Peel Park, offers your students the best of both worlds: state-of-the-art learning facilities within minutes of a world-class city, set against beautiful green spaces to relax and socialise in.

Peel Park campus includes our vibrant student village 'Peel Park Quarter', offering affordable luxury accommodation in a safe and secure environment. Students are a stone's throw from learning spaces, the library, Student's Union and campus shop.

MEDIA CITY UK CAMPUS

We are the only University to have a campus at MediaCityUK so if you're students are looking for a career within the media industry we couldn't be better placed. Our MediaCityUK campus shares a skyline with the BBC, ITV & Dock10 and everything they need for a world-class university experience.

Our MediaCityUK campus is connected to the Metrolink tram system, and the number 50 bus is free for students to travel between sites.



ACCOMMODATION & GREEN SPACES

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Our courses have individual entry requirements and some require specific subjects. Visit the full course information on our website to find out if this applies to the course your students are interested in. Our minimum entry requirement for a degree course is two A Levels or equivalent, but some courses will require three A Levels.

Most courses also require a minimum of grade 4 in GCSE English and Maths, (or grade c for qualifications taken prior to 2017), or a grade c

in both subjects where GCSE's are taken in Northern Ireland or Wales, however some may require a grade 5.

FINANCE

At the University of Salford, fees for students from the UK, EU, Channel Islands and Isle of Man studying a full-time undergraduate degree are £9,250* per year for the first year of study.

The fees for UK/EU students will vary depending on the number of credits taken per year. Financial support is available to undergraduate students to help with the cost of university, this may include a tuition fee loan and/or a maintenance loan.
