The PGCert Simulation in Health and Social Care will equip you with the contemporary knowledge and skills required to develop and advance simulation practice/education in your specific area of practice.

Through the course you will gain an understanding of the underpinning theory of simulation based education and you will spend time in the simulation suites applying this theory to practice.

The course can also form part of the MSc Nursing - Practice (Simulation) pathway.

COURSE CONTENT

This course is designed to give you the confidence to develop and advance simulation in your area of practice or education and is tailored specifically to your needs.

You will have the opportunity to study modules such as Theoretical Perspectives of Simulation-based Education and Practical Application of Simulation-based Education.
