
# BSc (Hons)





Choose between our two environmental geography pathways to either spend your second year studying at our partner institution, the University of Toledo (Ohio) in the USA, or undertake a placement in industry to gain professional experience.

The entry requirement for this degree is 112 UCAS points (Geography is preferred but not essential) and GCSE Maths / English at Grade C / Level 4.
