The Library has access to a collection of databases provided by Digimap. Our subscriptions include online access to a variety of maps, scans, satellite images and land coverage information.

The following Digimap collections are accessible via [Library Search](#) (search for Digimap). Support is available on the [Digimap website](#).

[Digimap: Environment](#)

This provides access to Land Cover Map data from the Centre for Ecology and Hydrology. This is a parcel-based classification of UK land cover derived from satellite images and digital cartography and gives land cover information for the entire UK. Land cover is based on UK Biodiversity Action Plan Broad Habitats.

[Digimap: Ordnance Survey](#)

This includes a variety of Ordnance Survey maps and licenced data.

[Digimap: Historic](#)

This provides access to the valuable historic Ordnance Survey map collection online. The maps included are digital scans of Ordnance Survey paper map sheets.

The historic maps can be viewed online, printed and downloaded as images for use in image processing and GIS software.
