COURSE SUMMARY

For candidates to be registered with the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC), an OSCE must be completed successfully by ALL nurses trained outside the UK, to enable them to work in the NHS as a registered Nurse.

The aim of this course is to prepare the candidate for the NMC Objective Structured Clinical examination (OSCE) assessment. This assessment enables nurses to register with the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) and to work in the NHS.

COURSE CONTENT

The course will provide candidates the opportunity to: -

- Explore and prepare for all the potential criteria that could be examined in the NMC Test of Competency Part 2: OSCE.
- Develop knowledge and understanding regarding the NMC Code of Professional Conduct, Raising and Escalating concerns, Performance and Ethics.
- Familiarise and receive feedback on your practice of the core elements set out in part 2 of the NMC test of competence including Assess, Implement, Plan & Evaluate care (AIPE), as well as clinical skills stations.
- Attend and engage in online workshops related to communication skills, and cultural aspects of care.

CAREER PROSPECTS

Following the preparation programme, you can apply to complete the OSCE exam at one of the 3 assessment centres based on Nottingham, Ulster or Oxford. Successful completion of the NMC OSCE at one of these centres will enable you to register with the NMC and work as a qualified nurse in the UK.
