


WORKING AT SALFORD

PAY



We offer competitive salaries, in line with The National Framework agreement, developed by UCEA (Universities & Colleges Employers association) and the HE trade unions.

Service-related incremental progression through the spine points in grades 1 to 10 occurs annually. We are also an accredited Real Living Wage Employer which means we pay the real living wage rate as a minimum to colleagues at the starting grades.

PENSION

We offer two pension schemes at Salford, USPP (University of Salford Pension Plan) and USS (Universities Superannuation Scheme). USPP is for staff on grades 1 to 6 and USS is for staff on grades 7 and above and hourly paid lecturers. Hourly paid lecturers are not enrolled automatically but they can opt in at any time. The University makes a significant employer contribution towards these pension schemes.

HOLIDAY ENTITLEMENT

We are committed to helping colleagues find a balance between their home and work life. We have a generous annual leave package which includes additional university closure days at Christmas. With our Holiday Carry Forward scheme, all colleagues also have the option to buy additional annual leave, to help you find the right balance. We also offer a range of family friendly benefits including maternity, paternity, shared parental responsibility, adoption and other special leave and support networks.



RECOGNITION



We believe that saying thank you is important. That's why our 'thank you' colleague recognition scheme is all about that. It gives colleagues across our University the opportunity to recognise peers and teams regularly. By sending a 'thank you', your colleague will receive an e-card and a copy will be sent to their manager, to make sure that the achievement is fully recognised.
